

JLab EH&S Committee - August 2003 Highlights

As of August 31st, Jefferson Lab had achieved [107](#) consecutive days without a lost-time injury. The Lab record is [455](#) consecutive. There were two recordable injuries in August.

The Physics Division ended a period of just over three years with no recordable injuries. This time period covered almost 1,000,000 work hours. This notable accomplishment reflects effective work planning and safe work behaviors. **(EH&S Reporting)**

Work is underway to prepare for installation of new ODH monitor electronics that will allow calibration without opening the accelerator tunnel. **(Accelerator)**

An enhanced version of the EH&S Tracking System became operational early in August. **(Accelerator)**

A Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) for the required annual welding machine preventive maintenance and inspection is now in place. The vendor is ARCET and the SOTR is Sandy Prior, ext. 7591. **(Accelerator)**

Air flow problems in hoods on the third floor of ARC resulted in suspension of use of these fume hoods. **(Accelerator)**

As part of the congressionally mandated investigation of the cost of transitioning DOE Science labs to external regulation a Federal OSHA team reviewed Jefferson Lab safety and health regulatory compliance during an August 11-15 visit. The OSHA team found no imminent danger or willful violations. **(EH&S Reporting)**
