

Severe Weather Planning Team

The Severe Weather Planning Team is convened by the Emergency Manager when forecasted conditions could affect JLab operations and personnel safety on site, and when so requested by the Facility Manager. It provides its recommendations to the Facility Manager for preparation actions. The Team has two principal aspects:

1. To evaluate forecasted conditions and provide information about current operations, schedules, and site conditions that could affect decision-making about storm preparations and site closing.
2. To serve as an information conduit to and from Lab groups and operations that have especially complex or time-intensive preparations to achieve the next level of preparedness for severe weather.

Members of the Severe Weather Team are recommended by the Emergency Manager, and have the concurrence of the Facility Manager and the members' management.
